The Inn gets its name from Lord William Howard. Born in 1563, he resided at the nearby Narworth Castle and was nicknamed 'Belted Will' by celebrated Scottish poet, Sir Walter Scott on account of the broad belt he wore. Scott's work, "Lay of the Last Minstrel" presents Lord William Howard as a rough border feudal lord of an earlier day. An extract is on the front page.

is situated in the village of Hallbankgate, nestling at the foot of the North Pennine Fells, on the edge of a designated area of outstanding natural beauty. We are three miles from the market town of Brampton, and twelve miles from the historic border city of Carlisle.
